

Pilots for Busking – Stage 2

1. NAC, with the support of venue partners and buskers, had successfully conducted one round of pilots at two outdoor venues between 4 and 19 December 2020, and obtained valuable feedback from the Buskers' Association, the busking community and venue partners.

Busking Pilots

2. Taking on board feedback from and reviewing prevalent safety management measures with various stakeholders, the NAC is pleased to embark on the 2nd round busking pilots as detailed below:

- Venues: *SCAPE, and The Central @ Clarke Quay
- Dates: 18 May 2021 onwards – with periodic reviews
- Duration: 1-hour sets (inclusive of set-up and tear-down)
- Eligible buskers: Individual, duo, trio buskers endorsed under the NAC Busking Scheme. Individuals/ busking groups (no more than 3 pax) who have previously registered as part of *SCAPE's busking sandbox, will also be eligible to participate in the pilot at *SCAPE.

3. We seek the public's cooperation to observe safe distancing (both amongst yourselves and between buskers and audiences), maintain the wearing of masks at all times, and continue to observe general hygiene. To show your support, the public may wish to contribute to these buskers via available collection box(es) and/or QR codes which will be located at a safe distance from the buskers.

Towards a Safe and Sustainable Re-opening

4. MCCY and NAC will closely monitor and review the outcomes of the pilots together with the participating venues and buskers on a regular basis. A safe and sustainable re-opening requires all of us to play our part. It is important that we continue to exercise caution, adhere to SMMs, and practise social responsibility. Collectively, we can progressively re-open our economy and society while remaining safe.
