

Suspension of Busking Activities from 26 March 2020, 23:59

In line with MOH's advisory issued on 24 March 2020, stricter social distancing measures have been put in place to reduce crowds in indoor and outdoor spaces. This includes the closure of entertainment venues (including bars, clubs, cinemas), as well as gatherings of not more than 10 people.

NAC has considered various options, recognising that we owe a duty of care to busker's personal health, the wellbeing of audiences and crowd concerns of venue partners. At this juncture, there is an urgent need to support national measures to reduce community transmission of COVID-19. As such, NAC will **suspend all busking activities** at designated and trial locations **with effect from 26 March 2020, 2359hours till 30 April 2020 inclusive.**

Please do not engage in any busking activities during this period; buskers who are found in breach will have their busking cards revoked immediately. The suspension of busking activities may be extended in line with MOH's advisory, and buskers should not resume busking activities until further notice from NAC.
