

## Foto-Foto Memory Lab 10 Day Writing Challenge Terms & Conditions

From 3 – 12 September 2020, daily participation prizes will be up for grabs and awarded to the first three (3) poems received by National Arts Council via Facebook or WhatsApp. Top 10 entries towards the 10 Day Writing Challenge (one per day) will be selected by Amanda Lee Koe to win limited edition festival collectibles.

1. This challenge is open to all residents of Singapore, except employees and immediate families of National Arts Council and advertising and sales promotion agencies.
2. This challenge is valid from 3 September 2020 to 30 September 2020. Any entries received after 30 September 2020 will not be entertained and will be disqualified.
3. The Participant may submit his or her Entry by posting his or her poem by
  - a. Commenting on the Foto-Foto Memory Lab 10 Day Writing Challenge post on Facebook (ensure profile is public), OR
  - b. Sending a message to the [Silver Arts Whatsapp channel](#).
4. Participants should post their completed Entry in the memory poem format detailed in the Foto Foto Memory Lab video and in response to the daily prompt released via the [Silver Arts Event page](#).
5. Any Entry that contains material that is deemed offensive is subject to immediate disqualification and deletion. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
  - a. Vulgarities, redacted or in full; or
  - b. Racist, sexist, and/or other discriminatory content.
6. There is no limit on the number of entries you can make but each Participant is eligible to win only one “Top 10” prize throughout the duration of the contest.
7. The first three (3) completed entries received each day will be eligible for the “Daily Participation” prizes.
8. Winners for the “Top 10” prizes will be selected on a merit basis, decided by writer Amanda Lee Koe.
9. Winners will be contacted by direct message on Facebook or WhatsApp regarding the prize collection arrangement.
10. Each Participant is required to provide a mailing address to receive the delivery of the Prize.
11. Uncollected prizes will be forfeited thirty (30) days from the date of the National Arts Council’s notification to winners.

12. Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.
13. National Arts Council reserves the right to change the prizes and the terms and conditions of the contest without any prior notice.

All entries received (qualified or disqualified) will be regarded as property of National Arts Council, who reserves the right to use the name and answers of all winners for publicity and/or advertising purposes. The copyright of each poem remains with the author. However, authors of the winning poems, by entering the competition, grant the NAC the right in perpetuity to publish and/or broadcast their poem.
