### **National Heritage Board Scholarships**

In place since 2008, the NHB scholarship scheme provides financial assistance for promising talents in Singapore to pursue full-time undergraduate or postgraduate studies in the fields of heritage and/or museum management or administration. The scholarship quantum covers both full and partial sponsorships; the partial scholarship covers 100% of study costs, capped at \$100,000. Scholars will be bonded to NHB for six years for full scholarship and three years for partial scholarship after their studies. Till date, 12 scholars have benefitted from this scholarship.
