



What is the Patron of the Arts Awards?

The Patron of the Arts Awards was instituted in 1983 to recognise organisations and individuals that have contributed towards the promotion of cultural and artistic activities in Singapore. The 2015 Awards recognises contributions made between 1 January and 31 December 2014.

AWARD CATEGORIES FOR CORPORATES

Distinguished Patron of the Arts Award

This award recognises contributions of \$1,500,000 and above in a year.

Patron of the Arts Award

This award recognises contributions between \$300,000 and \$1,499,999.

Friend of the Arts Award

This award recognises contributions between \$50,000 and \$299,999.

SG50 ARTS PATRON AWARD

In conjunction with Singapore's Golden Jubilee and to show appreciation to long-term patrons of the arts, a special SG50 Arts Patron Award is presented to 21 corporations who have been instrumental in shaping Singapore's arts scene today. The award is conferred on patrons who have:

- Contributed more than \$1.5 million in the last 5 years; or
- Outstanding accomplishment with ten (10) or more Distinguished Patron of the Arts awards.

AWARD CATEGORIES FOR INDIVIDUALS

Distinguished Patron of the Arts Award

This award recognises contributions of \$100,000 and above in a year.

Patron of the Arts Award

This award recognises contributions between \$50,000 and \$99,999.

Friend of the Arts Award

This award recognises contributions between \$10,000 and \$49,999.
