National Heritage Board Scholarships

In place since 2008, the NHB Scholarship scheme supports promising talents in Singapore to pursue full-time undergraduate or postgraduate studies in the fields of heritage and/or museum management or administration.

The full scholarship is awarded only once for the duration of the study and is non-renewable. Some of the areas of study allowed under the Scheme are:

- Conservation
- Museum Education
- Curatorial Studies
- History (Singapore and Southeast Asia)
- Cultural and Heritage Management

Upon successful completion of studies, the NHB scholar will be in the employment of NHB serving a 3-year (for overseas partial scholarship or local scholarship) or 6-year (for overseas full scholarship) bond on a full-time basis.

*Postgraduate studies refer to studies leading to a Master's qualification and above.
