

## Suspension of Busking Activities till Further Notice

As restrictions are still in place for most live entertainment activities, busking activities continue to be suspended at designated and trial locations.

Hence, NAC will further extend the validity of busking cards according to the table below, which supersedes the table published on 29 May 2020.
